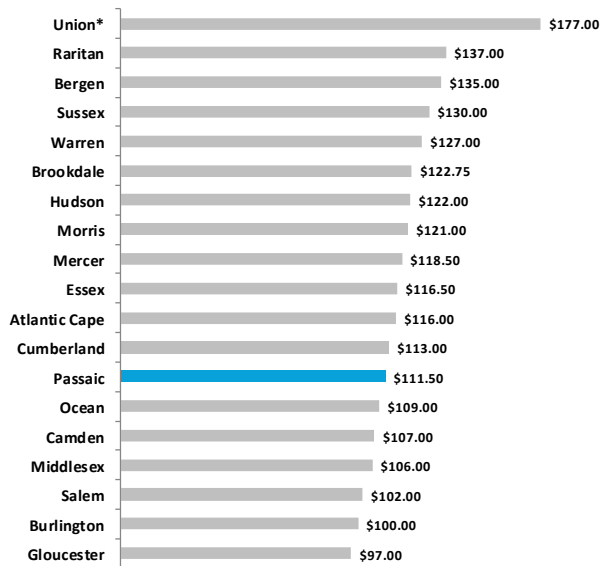
Financial Aid for First-time Full-time Students by Type, AY 2014-2015:

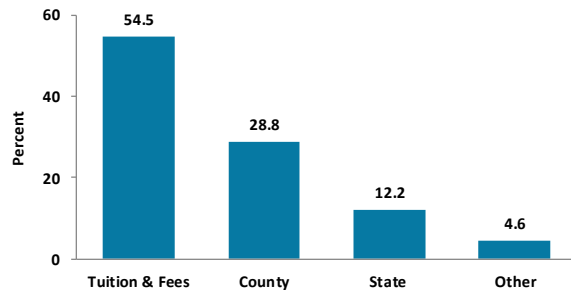
Per Credit In-District Tuition in NJ Community Colleges, AY 2015-2016

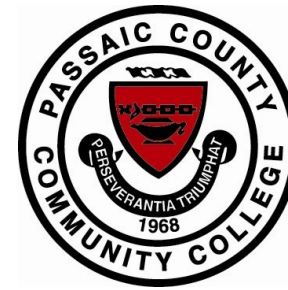

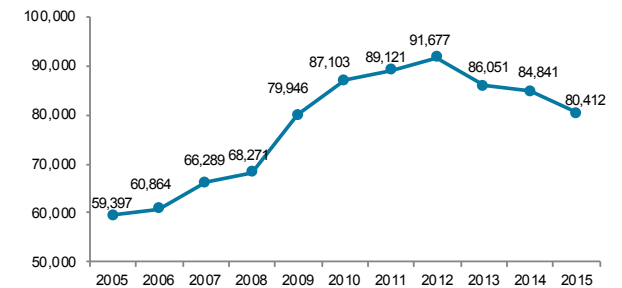

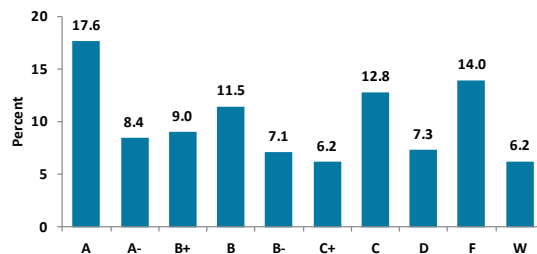

Overall Grade Distribution: Fall 2015



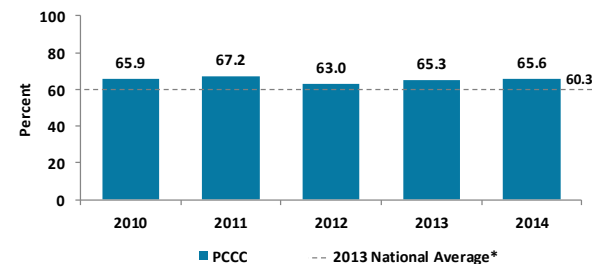

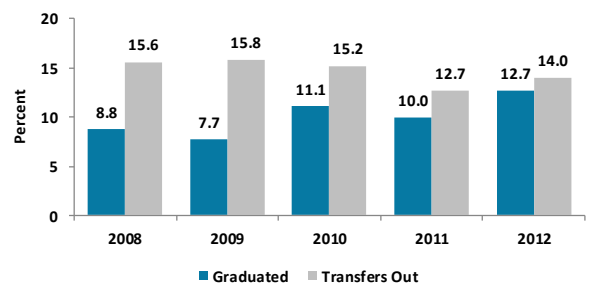
One Year Retention Rate for First-time Full-time Degree-Seeking Students: Fall 2010 - Fall 2014
